

APPOINTMENTS

NEW PATIENT CLINIC

Each person referred to the medical oncologist/haematologist by a surgeon/GP/other specialist, will attend a new patient clinic for assessment and decision regarding treatment options.

Your medical history and recent investigations will be discussed with you and your family/support persons. Chemotherapy treatment options will be explained and discussed with you to assist you with making an informed decision. Consent is obtained at this time.

CHEMOTHERAPY CLINIC

Once a decision is made with you to proceed with chemotherapy, an appointment will be made to attend a chemotherapy clinic in order to prescribe the chemotherapy treatment. You will receive verbal and written information regarding your chemotherapy treatment. You will be regularly reviewed by medical staff during your treatment.

FOLLOW-UP CLINICS

These clinics are held for patients who have completed their chemotherapy treatment and are now on surveillance from their specialist. Not all patients require follow-up.
